## Families Served Through Evidence-Based Home Visiting in 2020

Data in this profile represent tribal-led organizations implementing Early Head Start Home-Based Option, Family Spirit, Healthy Families America, Maternal Infant Health Program, Nurse-Family Partnership, Parents as Teachers, and SafeCare Augmented. Nationwide, 132 tribal-led organizations implemented at least one of these models.

## Potential Beneficiaries in 2020

Nationally, there were 332,600 American Indian/Alaska Native pregnant women and families with children under 6 years old not yet in kindergarten who could benefit from home visiting. These families included 423,700 children.

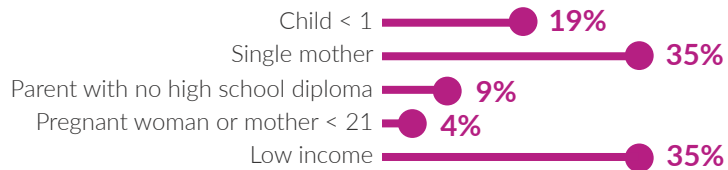

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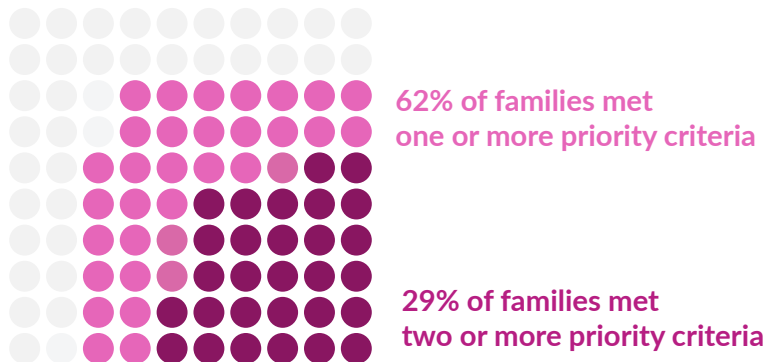

The number of children served in 2019 was included as a proxy for children and families served in 2020. • American Indian/Alaska Native pregnant women and families were identified by the race of mother or other primary caregiver and includes those who reported American Indian/Alaska Native alone or as one of multiple races. • Low income is defined as family income below the federal poverty threshold. • Single mothers include single, never married mothers or pregnant women.
