
## **New Mexico**

### Families Served Through Evidence-Based Home Visiting in 2022

Models implemented in New Mexico included Early Head Start Home-Based Option, Family Connects, Family Spirit, Nurse-Family Partnership, Parents as Teachers, and Promoting First Relationships. Statewide, 47 local agencies operated at least one of these models.

In New Mexico, there were 108,500 pregnant women and families with children under 6 years old not yet in kindergarten who could benefit from home visiting. These families included 141,800 children.
