


ParentChild+

[ParentChild+](#), formerly called the Parent-Child Home Program, supports families with young children living in historically marginalized communities in accessing a path to possibility. ParentChild+ has an international network of local program sites whose highly trained, community-based, linguistically-matched early learning specialists (ELs) partner with families (One-on-One Family Home Visiting model) and home-based child care providers (Home-Based Childcare model) to support adult-child interaction and ensure children achieve their greatest potential in school and life.

What is the model's approach to providing home visiting services?	<p>Home visits take place twice per week for a minimum of 46 weeks (92 visits total). ParentChild+ works with families when their children are between the ages of 16 months and 4 years old. Children typically enter the program at 2 years old and exit as they transition to pre-K or a Head Start center-based program.</p> <p>ParentChild+'s service population includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Families with low incomes✓ Families experiencing language or literacy barriers✓ Families experiencing social isolation✓ Caregivers with limited access to education✓ Immigrant/refugee families✓ Families experiencing housing insecurity
Who is implementing the model?	<p>Home Visitors</p> <p>ParentChild+ was implemented by 638 community-based ELs in 2022. The model requires ELs to have educational, work, and/or life experience relevant to the work and their community; be fluent in their families' home languages; share a cultural/community background with their families; and to have lived or worked in the communities they serve. The maximum caseload for experienced ELs is 15 families.</p> <p>Supervisors</p> <p>ParentChild+ was implemented by 235 community-based site coordinators in 2022. The model recommends that community-based site coordinators have educational, work, and/or life experience relevant to the work and their community.</p>

Where is the model implemented?	 <p>ParentChild+ operated in 119 local agencies across 14 states in 2022. ParentChild+ also operated outside the United States and its territories in Bermuda, Canada, Chile, Ireland, Singapore, and the United Kingdom in 2022.</p>

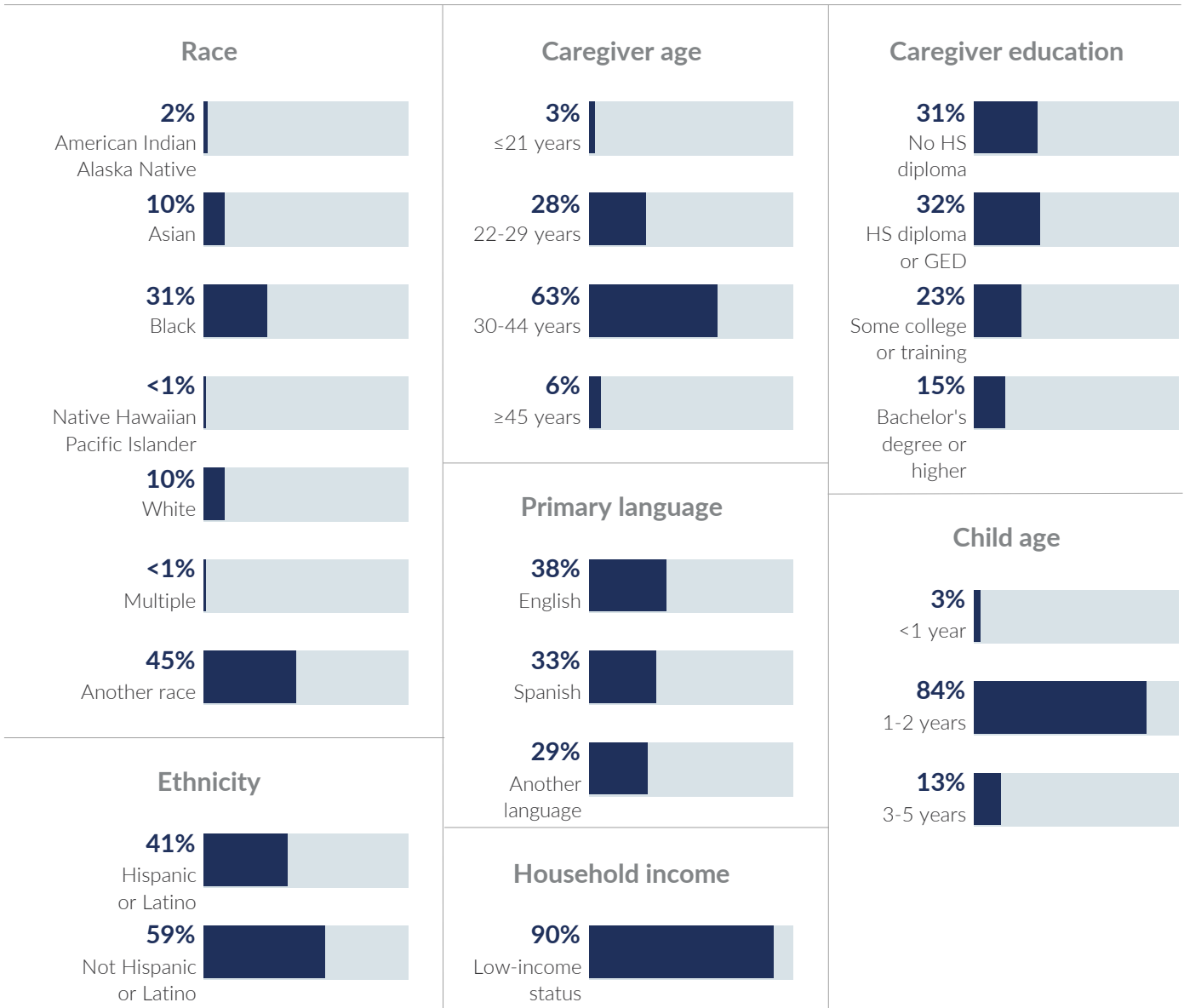

In 2020-2021, the model provided an increased number of virtual visits to meet families' needs. • ParentChild+ reached an additional 1,462 caregivers and families and completed an additional 43,860 home visits through its Home-Based Child Care model in 2022.
