Evidence-based models implemented with MIECHV funds in Minnesota included Healthy Families America, Maternal Early Childhood Sustained Home-Visiting, Nurse-Family Partnership, and Parents as Teachers. Statewide, MIECHV funded 40 full-time equivalent (FTE) home visitors and 8 FTE supervisors. FTE can include full-time and part-time staff.
