Evidence-based models implemented with MIECHV funds in Virginia included Healthy Families America, Nurse-Family Partnership, and Parents as Teachers. Statewide, MIECHV funded 56 full-time equivalent (FTE) home visitors and 12 FTE supervisors. FTE can include full-time and part-time staff.
