★ Gather to discuss and interpret stories as community listening process








#### **Working with Stories**

- ★ Work with your partner/s to group similar stories together (by themes, categories, who is involved, etc)
- ★ Give each story group a title write on a sticky note.
- ★ Choose an example story that best represents group.

- ★ What kinds of patterns did you notice in your stories?
- ★ What surprised you?
- ★ What did you expect to see, but didn't?

- ★ We share the same destination, but there are many paths to get there.


#### **Actionables**

- Neighborhood playdates, visiting your neighbors


